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Feed Labelling On-line Course

This training course has been designed to explain and simplify the legislation covering the labelling of feed materials and compound feeds, incorporating a practical element to the design and inspection of feed labels. Moving the course on-line has allowed us to deliver the course with an interactive format, demonstrating how to use these regulations, and using the delegates own labels, or our examples to illustrate this. As well as guiding delegates through labelling principles, it includes working examples of key feed additives, and how they should be declared on compound feed labels. We complete the course with the list of products for nutritional purposes, and the labelling requirements for some commonly made claims.
